

MEURSAULT-CAILLERETS PREMIER CRU Meursault Caillerets

The quantity of red wines produced in Meursault 1er Cru is very low.

Despite the fact that the 14 climates of the 1er Crus are classified both in white wines and red wines, the appellation may vary depending on whether the cépage is white or red.

Therefore, the white wines produced among the four 1er Crus of Blagny take the appellation Meursault Blagny. On the same climates, the red wines are called Blagny 1er Cru. Likewise, most of the 1er Crus in the north, next to Volnay take the appellation Volnay Santenots for red wines and Meursault Santenots for white wines. Except for the little climate of Meursault Caillerets, contiguous to Volnay Caillerets, which takes the appellation Meursault Caillerets for red and white wines.

Meursault Caillerets only covers 1 hectare on which the Domaine Latour-Giraud owns almost 1/5 of the 18 ares, very close to Volnay Caillerets.

The lightness and the little depth of the very stony soil produce a colorfull wine, extremely elegant, delicate, of a very important fineness, soft and fruity with a fine suggestiv bouquet of violets.
