

MEURSAULT-GENEVRIERES PREMIER CRU Meursault Genevrières

Meursault is in the heart of three villages in the Côte de Beaune, well known as the "Côte des Blancs". The vineyards of these villages, Meursault, Puligny and Chassagne spread over 7 km, characterized by a mosaic of limestone soil, ideally suited to Chardonnay grapes. On the 430 hectares of vineyards, predominant with white wines, sorted in three classifications, Meursault, Meursault 1er Cru and Meursault Blagny, a 33% is classified in 1er Cru.

The vineyards of Genevrières equal a total of 16 hectares in the heart of the Meursault 1er Crus, south of the village. The name of this appellation comes from the juniper trees that used to grow there a long time ago. It is sometimes said that the taste of the flowers of this tree used to be felt in the wine.

The Domaine Latour-Giraud is most important owner of this fabulous 1er Cru, with 2.50 hectares. Very famous with the Perrières on top of the 1er Crus of Meursault.

The wine produced by the Gehevrières of Latour-Giraud is of an exquisite structure. The roundness is deep and smooth, of elegant fineness and race.

Gastronomy: go well with duck liver paté and sea fish.

Temperature: 13°C-14°C Conservation: up to 10 years
